What is a Neighbourhood Voice?

In some cases there may not be enough interested residents/tenants to form a residents' association. In this instance residents can still participate as they would in a Residents' Association by becoming a Neighbourhood Voice. This offers the same recognised and formal participation as being part of a Residents' Association and as a Neighbourhood Voice you can sit on the Tenant/Resident Consultation Panel.
