Objective was to discuss and commission schemes for the 2010/11 financial year using Throston's annual Working Neighbourhoods Fund (WNF) allocation. The proposed schemes were a combination of new projects and continuations from 2009/10.

The following project proposals were presented to the meeting attendees:

Continuation schemes from 2009/10

- **Re-engaging with Learning** (Hartlepool Adult Education): £5,600
- **Streetlife Youth Fitness Programme** (Throston Youth Project): £3,514
- **Stop Smoking Drop-in Clinic** (Stockton and Hartlepool Specialist Stop-Smoking Service): £2004.50
- **Holiday Activities 2010** (Throston Youth Project): £2,000
- **Summer Activities Programme** (Sure Start Children's Centre): £1,164

New schemes

- **Throston Eco Communal Garden** (Throston Primary School): £4,500
- **Goals and Storage Project** (Brinkburn FC): £2,000
- **Throston Café Project** (Hartlepool Borough Council): £2,000
- **Introduction to gentle exercise** (Hartlepool Borough Council): £297.60
- **Kids Club** (Throston Grange Library): £270
